Log onto your Gryph Mail

Log onto your [Gryph Mail](#) account and download the app to your phone or laptop so that you get notifications when a new email comes in. This will be the University's main way of contacting you throughout the year.



Test New Technologies

Once they become available, be sure to review your course outlines and see what technologies you'll be using (e.g., Zoom, Teams, etc.). Download these tools in advance and test them out before your first class to avoid technical difficulties.



Set Up an Agenda
