SAMPLE Course Honour Code

This resource provides a sample Course Honour Code that instructors can use to support students around issues of academic integrity. Research shows that having students read such statements before participating in a course, taking an online quiz, test or exam, or submitting an assignment deters students from behaving dishonourably, and helps support students learning about academic integrity.

We recommend that you cut and copy this sample to make it your own based on your needs and context; discuss with colleagues to see how they are managing Honour Codes.
